

# MAPLE LEAF


12 1/2" sq. unfinished

Cut  
from background fabric  
2 squares 3" (B)  
2 squares 3 3/8" (C)

for maple leaf  
3 squares 3" (A)  
2 squares 3 3/8" (D)  
1 rectangle 1 1/2" x 4 3/4" (stem)

for borders

4 rectangles 2 3/4" x 8" (F)  
16 squares 1 5/8" (G) multicolors as desired



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of background fabric C.  
Place a background square C on a maple leaf D square  
right sides together. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line.  
Cut on the line. Press seam allowances toward the leaf  
fabric C. Each half-square triangle should measure 3" x 3".  
make 4 half-square triangles (C-D units).

For stem block - press under 1/4" on long edges of E. Place  
diagonally on B square and sew close to edges.

Lay out B, C/D units, A and B-stem units as shown  
to make 3 rows for maple leaf as shown. Sew rows  
together.

for border - sew 4 G units to make 4 blocks 2 3/4" x 2 3/4"  
sew these to the ends of 2 F blocks.  
sew 2 F blocks to sides of maple leaf block  
sew F-G units to opposite sides of leaf block.
