COVERED BRIDGE Found in Lap Quilting with Georgia Bonesteel, Oxmoor House, 1982.

Cut from Light colored fabric

 $2-3 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares

1- 6 ¾ inch square — cut diagonally into 2 triangles

2 — Quarter Circle C (see pattern on reverse)

Cut from Dark colored fabric

2 — Curved Square B (on reverse)

2 — 4 inch squares, then cut diagonally to form

2 — Trapezoid B (on reverse)

4 triangles

Cut from Print fabric


2 — Trapezoid B

SEW TOGETHER This is the order I sewed it But you can do it any way you wish.

Top — Sew Quarter Circle C to Curved Square B — Sew small dark triangles to side and top of resulting square — sew the resulting triangle to the large light triangle — then sew the two sides together.

Bottom- Sew short sides of Trapezoids to small squares, then sew diagonally to the corner - sew two sides together.

Sew Top to the Bottom!
