


How to Make a Quilt

Quick Triangle-Squares

The Fons & Porter Quarter Inch Seam Marker offers a neat way to mark accurate sewing lines for this method.

- 1. From 1 light and 1 dark fabric, cut 1 square 1/8" larger than the desired finished size of triangle-square.
- 2. Place Quarter Inch Seam Marker diagonally across wrong side of light square, positioning yellow center line exactly at corners. Mark stitching guidelines along both sides of Quarter Inch Seam Marker (Photo A). NOTE: If you are not using the Fons & Porter Quarter Inch Seam Marker, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner across square. Then draw sewing lines on each side of the first line, 1/4" away.
- 3. Place light square on dark square, right sides facing; stitch along marked sewing lines.
- 4. Cut between rows of stitching to make 2 triangle-squares (Photo B). Press seam allowances toward darker fabric.
