Disappearing Four Patch Block By Jenny Doan Missouri Star Quilt Company


Cutting:

Start with 2 7"square dark fabric


2 7" square light fabric

Disappearing four patch assembly

- 1. Lay out 4 squares as in diagram. Sew together like our patch
- 2. Next place the 1" line of the ruler along the center seam line, cut the four patch as shown in cutting diagrams.



3. Being careful not to move pieces, rotate cutting mat one quarter turn. Place the 1" line of the ruler along seam line, cut four patch again. Continue in this manner until you have made 4 cuts.



- 4. Now swap large squares at the top, and large squares at the bottom as shown in Block Assembly diagrams. Then rotate small center square one quarter turn.
- 5. Join cut pieces into rows: join rows (basic 9 patch) to complete a Disappearing Four Patch Block.
