

## Card trick

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

You can use 4 colors and a background as in the illustration or just two colors and the background, whichever you like.

A triangles - From your background fabric cut (2) 4 7/8" squares then cut on the diagonal to make 4 triangles.

B triangles -Cut one 5 3/16" square from the background fabric then cut on the diagonal in both directions to cut 4 B triangles.

C rectangles - for each color you are using cut a rectangle 3 5/16" x 6 3/16".

D squares - for each color you are using cut a 3 5/16" square.

## PIECING THE BLOCK

I lay my pieces out as shown in the colored illustration and then piece according to the directions.

Piece 2 C rectangles with 2 B triangles. Press toward the rectangle. Make 2 units this way. Add the A triangles to these units.

Piece the squares together to form a four patch. On each side of your four patch sew a rectangle matching the color of the rectangle to a square as shown in the illustration.

Next sew 2 BCB units to the two sides. Press and you are done.

Your completed block should measure 12 1/2".
