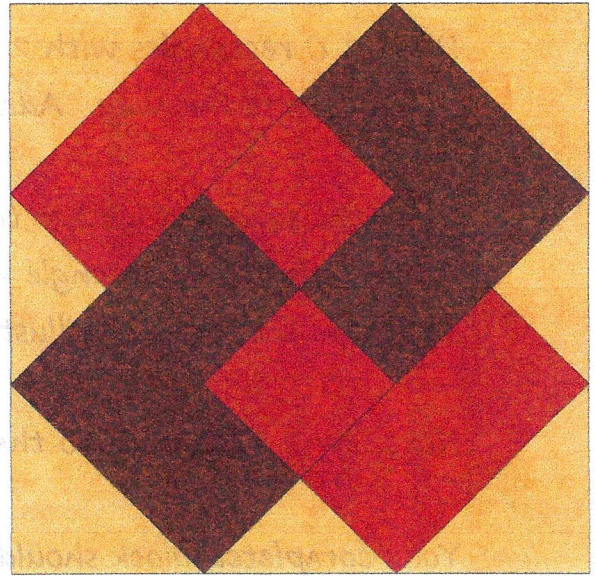
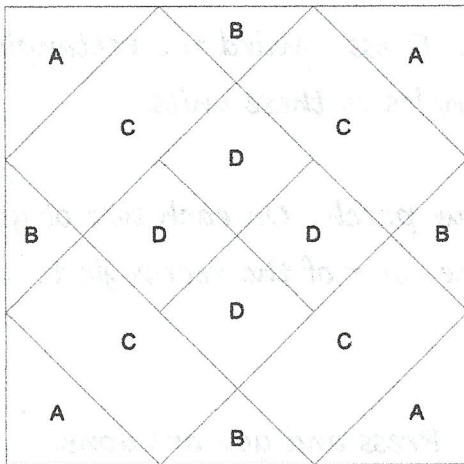


Card trick

Key Block (1/5 actual size)



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

You can use 4 colors and a background as in the illustration or just two colors and the background, whichever you like.

A triangles - From your background fabric cut (2) $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares then cut on the diagonal to make 4 triangles.

B triangles - Cut one $5 \frac{3}{16}$ " square from the background fabric then cut on the diagonal in both directions to cut 4 B triangles.

C rectangles - for each color you are using cut a rectangle $3 \frac{5}{16}$ " x $6 \frac{3}{16}$ ".

D squares - for each color you are using cut a $3 \frac{5}{16}$ " square.

PIECING THE BLOCK

I lay my pieces out as shown in the colored illustration and then piece according to the directions.

Piece 2 C rectangles with 2 B triangles. Press toward the rectangle.
Make 2 units this way. Add the A triangles to these units.

Piece the squares together to form a four patch. On each side of your
four patch sew a rectangle matching the color of the rectangle to a
square as shown in the illustration.

Next sew 2 BCB units to the two sides. Press and you are done.

Your completed block should measure $12 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
