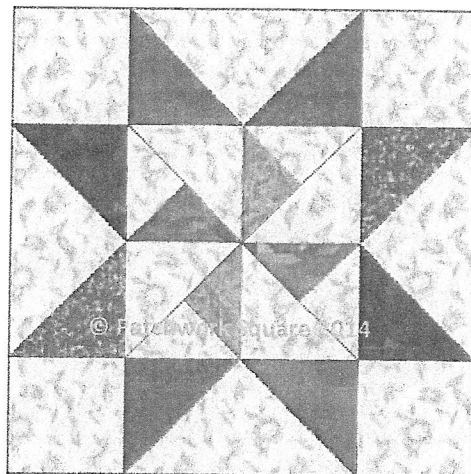





Martha Washington Star

Fabric Placement



How-to Notes	
	Bisect square on one diagonal
	Bisect square on both diagonals

<p>1</p> 	<p>Background fabric</p> <p>Cut 4 squares 3 1/2"</p> <p>Cut 2 squares 3 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal</p> <p>Cut 1 square 4 1/4" and bisect on both diagonals</p> <p>Cut 1 square 7 1/4" and bisect on both diagonals</p>
<p>2</p> 	<p>Assorted fabrics (or one fabric) for "star"</p> <p>Cut 4 squares 3 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal</p>
<p>3</p> 	<p>Assorted fabrics (or one fabric) for centre "pinwheel"</p> <p><i>*Note 1—one fabric will yield 4 triangles</i></p> <p>Cut 1 (or 2) squares 4 1/4" and bisect on both diagonals (you will need a total of 4 triangle pieces, so if using 2 fabrics, you will have extra triangle pieces)</p> <p><i>*Note 2—Cutting is done in this manner to keep straight of grain on outer edge of quilt patch</i></p>

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
